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Introduction

Ung i Skåne is addressed to young people between the ages of 13-25 and the aim of the project is to increase participation and involvement of young people in the society. Young people in Skåne can apply for up to 25 000 SEK in support of carrying out a project. The young people plan and run their own projects and, if necessary, with support from a youth coach. The projects must be by and for young people. Ung i Skåne is based on collaboration between three youth projects in different leader areas in Skåne.

<u>Ung i MittSkåne</u> - Eslöv, Hörby & Höörs municipality

<u>Unga Ess</u> - Bromölla, Kristianstads, Osby & Östra Göinge municipality

<u>La Source</u> - Simrishamns, Sjöbo, Tomelilla & Ystads municipality

The projects that collaborate in Ung i Skåne are financed by two funds: the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development and the European Regional Development Fund with a total of 1 461 000 SEK available for young people's projects. Since the spring of 2018, 50 projects have been completed. These are presented in more detail in this status report, divided into the different Leader areas.



Y-LAG

About Y-LAG

All three youth projects in Ung i Skåne are structured in a similar way with sub-projects where young people in simpler forms can apply for financial support to create and arrange events and activities for themselves and other young people. La Source has a youth board, Y-LAG*, linked to the project. In Ung i Mittskåne and Unga Ess there are plats to start youth boards in the spring of 2021.

Working with Y-LAG is a proven model that has been used successfully in several leader areas in the previous program period. In La Source, the young people in Y-LAG have the role of decision-makers where they can be involved, influence and direct the project. Y-LAG's main task is to decide which sub-proiects are to be supported financially by La Source. The young people in Y-LAG act as ambassadors for Leader and their mission also includes spreading information to other young people about how to apply for money at La Source. Y-LAG consists of 8 young people aged 14-21 with representation from all of the Leader area's four municipalities. Below, one of the members of Y-LAG talks about what it is like to be part of the youth board.

*LAG means Local Action Group which is the board of a Leader area.

Why did you choose to apply to Y-LAG?

It seemed like a more serious and fun way to be able to express your ideas and thoughts. When you are still quite creative, it sounded fun to have a place where your ideas can be developed and built on by other talented young people.

What is the best thing about being part of Y-LAG?

To meet young people with different backgrounds, thoughts and interests but with the same goal. We are all extremely different in Y-LAG but we help each other, build on each other's ideas and come up with solutions. Then it's fantastic fun to see when your ideas go to fulfillment and not just stay as an idea.

What is it like to be young and be involved and able to influence?

It is extremely interesting and instructive. I myself have always had the impression that I have to sit around and wait until I am an adult to be able to influence. But now you have realized that it is not very difficult to influence, you just have to see your possibilities and find people who are willing to listen.




Ung i MittSkåne

Ung i MittSkåne turns to young people between the ages of 13-25 and the aim of the project is to increase participation and commitment in the democracy process in rural areas. Through Ung i MittSkåne, young people in the municipalities of Eslöv, Höör and Hörby can apply for up to 20 000 SEK in support of realizing a project. The young people plan and run their own projects with support from a youth coach. The projects must be by and for young people.

Ung i MittSkåne is financed by the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development and European regional development fund with a total budget of 311 000 SEK. During the project period, August 2018 to June 2020, 13 projects were completed. These are presented in more detail in the section projects in MittSkåne.

Why is it important to include young people in rural areas?

In order for there to be a balance. Including young people in rural areas creates new developed societies where different perspectives meet that are highlighted to create new collaborations and projects.




Unga Ess

The Unga Ess project is aimed at young people aged 13-25 in Bromölla, Kristianstad, Osby and Östra Göinge municipality. The purpose of the project is to make young people feel greater participation and influence for their hometown, and to capture and support young people's commitment and drive.

Through the project, young people can apply for up to 25 000 SEK to complete their projects. A project manager / youth coach is employed at Skånes Ess to support, engage and help the young people. Through various events, meetings, outreach activities and collaborations with organizations, associations and activities that work for and with young people, young people's drive and commitment to their hometown will be utilized.

The project is funded by two funds, the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development and the European Regional Development Fund. A total of 750 000 SEK is available for young people's projects.



La Source


La Source is addressed to young people between the ages of 13-25 and the aim of the project is to make young people's initiatives visible and support their opportunities to influence their everyday lives and leisure in the countryside. Through La Source, young people in the municipalities of Sjöbo, Tomelilla, Simrishamn and Ystad can apply for up to 25 000 SEK in support of realizing a project idea that they dream of implementing.

The overall goal of the project is to take advantage of young people's commitment and let them create their own sub-projects so that they feel involved in the development of the place where they live. Young people plan and run their own projects with support from a youth coach. The projects must be by and for young people.

La Source is financed by the rural fund for agricultural development with a total of 400 000 SEK. During the project period, October 2019 to January 2022, so far, 11 projects have been completed.

There is a youth board for the project (Y-LAG) connected with young people between 13-25 years from all four municipalities that have the task of inspiring and supporting other young people who want to implement their project ideas. The youth board also makes decisions about which sub-projects to be granted money.


Kreativt entreprenörskap

ÖMT's A-traktorbygge



10 tips for successful inclusion of young people:

- 1. Let young people be a part of the decisions that affect them, preferably as active decision-makers in, for example, boards or youth councils
- 2. Use young people as ambassadors reach young people through other young people
- 3. Simplify the administration around application, accounting and finances it should be easy to do things right!
- 4. Highlight concrete examples to inspire and kick-start the creativity of young people
- 5. Identify and utilize existing networks for young people to reach the target group
- 6. Collaborate with relevant actors who have an established contact with young people e.g. leisure leaders, association leaders or teachers
- 7. Reach young people in the young people's arena and in the channels and forums the young people are at
- 8. Create a strategy and plan for social media and follow the plan!
- 9. Encourage young people to commit to democracy and social issues by inviting young people into various networks
- Pay attention to and support young people's initiatives and commitment as an important part of societal development



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
