The Absolut Vodka brand is one of Sweden's most well-known brands internationally. The factory and distillery that produces the Absolut range is situated in the Skånes Ess Leader region, in the town of Åhus. Absolut, and the present owner Pernod-Ricard is a large company, but the Absolut distillery is probably the most environmentally low-impact in the world with many circular flows, and both raw materials and glass for the bottles are locally sourced.

Ecotopia is an educational center for sustainable solutions. At Ecotopia, courses are held in organic farming, eco-building/straw bale construction, sustainable sewage and heating solutions etc. Here we will have lunch, listen to presentations, discuss, and get a guided tour.

Presentation 1: Martin Behm, working for the organization Economy for the common good (ECG), whose economic model Ecotopia uses as a basis for their work, and founder of sustainability consultant firm Make Thrive. He will share insights into how businesses can evolve and reinvent their business models, services and strategies to create sustainable, competitive brands while serving the common good.

Presentation 2: **Karin Malmgren**, founder of Ecotopia. Karin will share some information of how Ecotopia functions, some examples of sustainable practices businesses can apply, and will bring us on a small tour to look at the sustainable and circular construction and energy technologies used at Ecotopia.
